Building Sentences:

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Use this set of high-frequency word cards for multileveled practice in making and reading sentences.

Teacher preparation for both activities: Print, cut, and laminate the word cards. They will print clearly in grayscale, but printing in color will give your students additional clues about placement in the sentence: green (start), white, then red (stop).

Level 1: Students will use the task card as a model to construct 5 sentences. They will then choose one of the sentences to copy and illustrate.

Level 2: Students will use the cards to construct their own sentences about soccer. On the provided response form, they will write the sentences they make and mark the longest sentence with a star.
